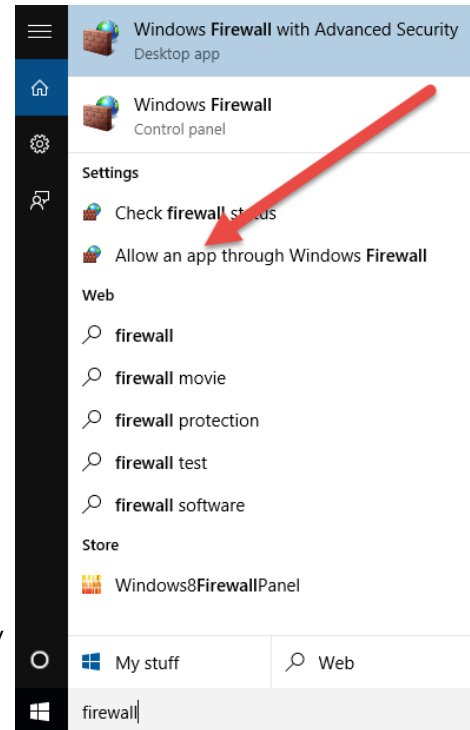
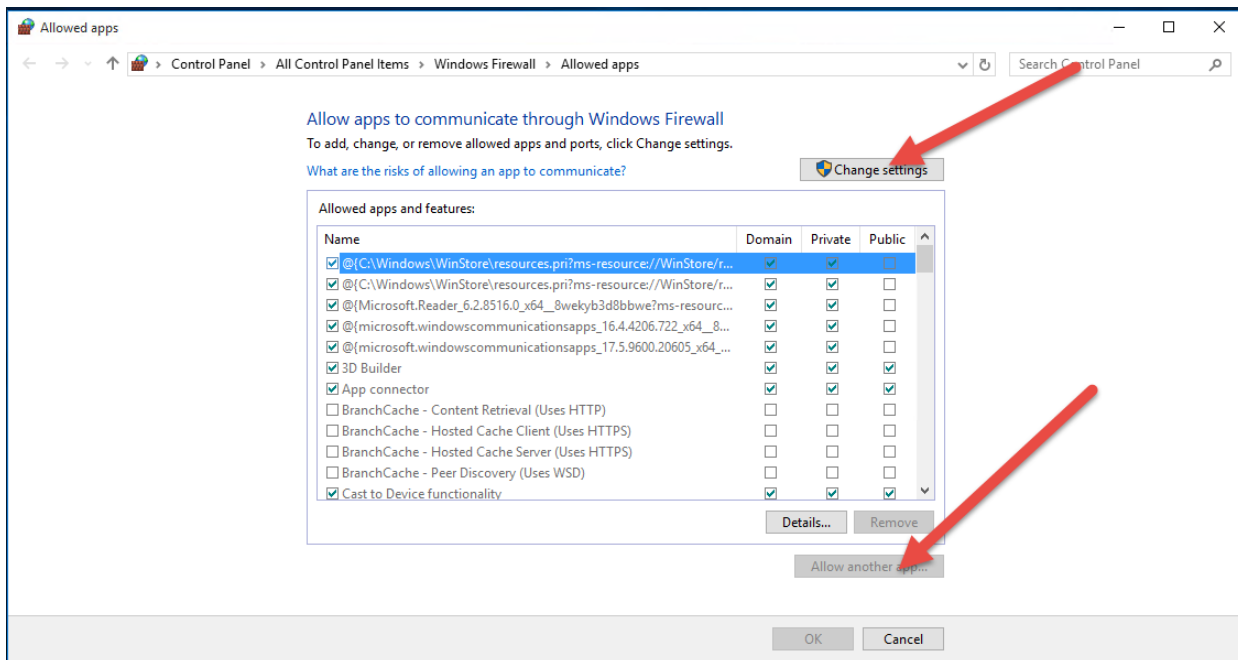


Click on the *Windows Start* button and type *Firewall*

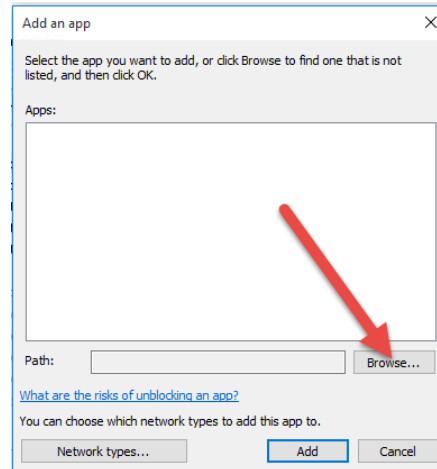
From the list of choices, choose *Allow an app through Windows Firewall*



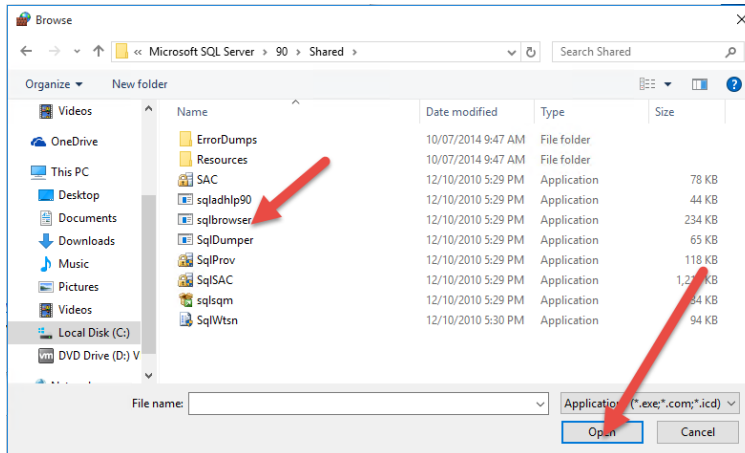
The following screen comes up. Click on *Change settings* and then *Allow another app*



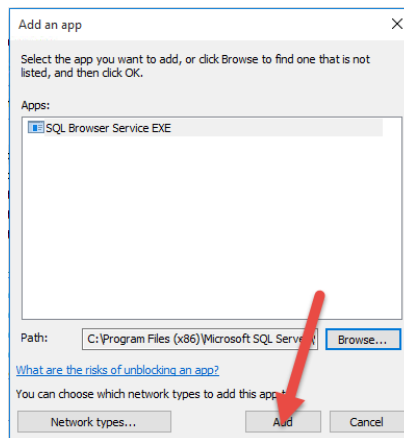
Click *Browse* to search for the first app.



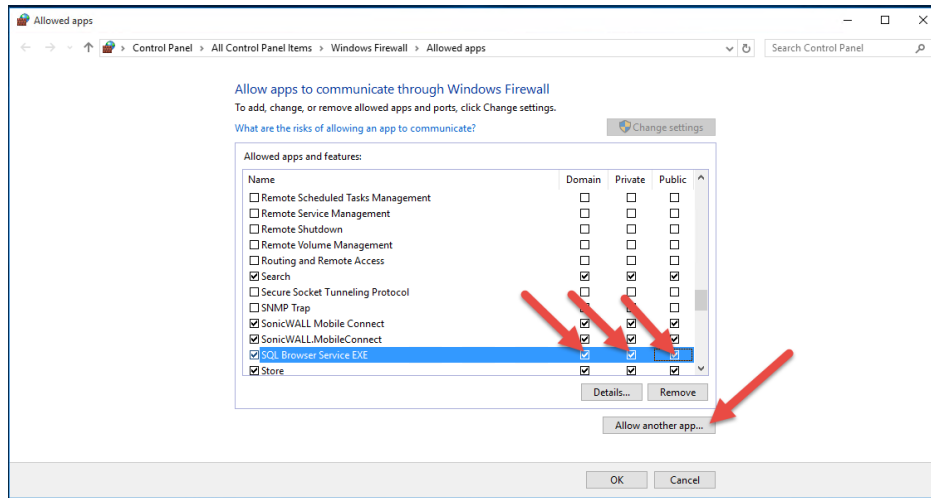
Browse to *C:\Program Files(x86)\Microsoft SQL server\90\Shared* and select *SQLBROWSER.exe* and click the *Open* button.



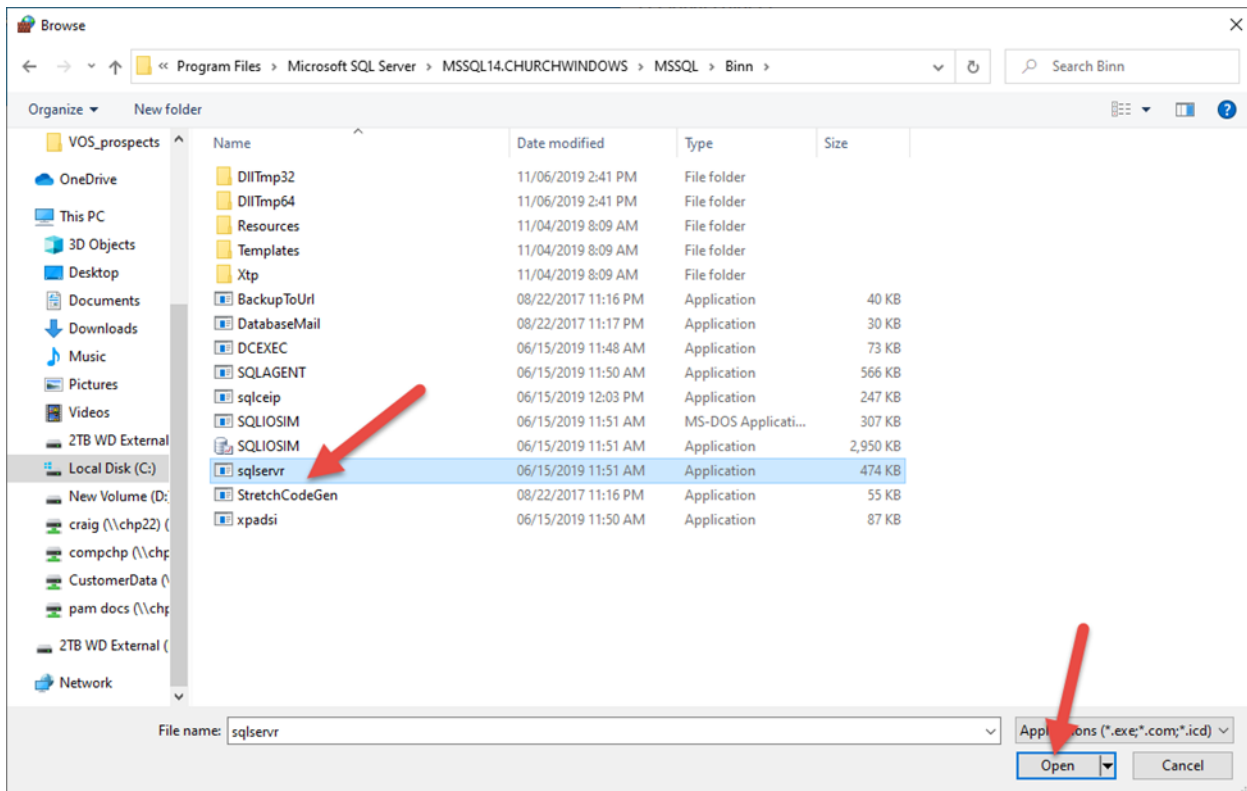
This puts the *SQL Browser Service EXE* into the *Add an app* screen – click *Add*



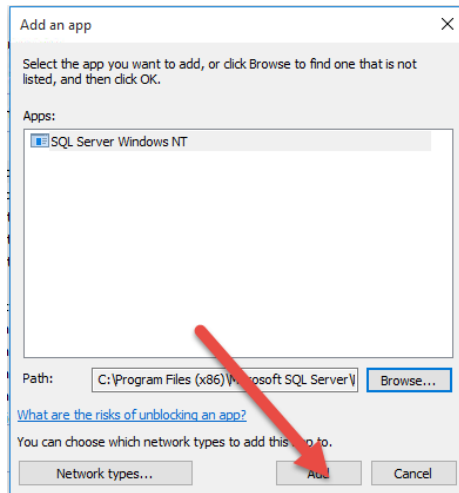
Make sure all of your firewalls (up to 3) are selected and then click *Allow another app*



Browse to C:\Program Files\Microsoft SQL Server\MSSQL14.CHURCHWINDOWS\MSSQL\Binn then select the SQLSERVR.exe file and click Open.



This puts the SQL Server Windows NT into the *Add an app* screen – click *Add*



Again, make sure all of your firewalls are selected and then click *OK*.
